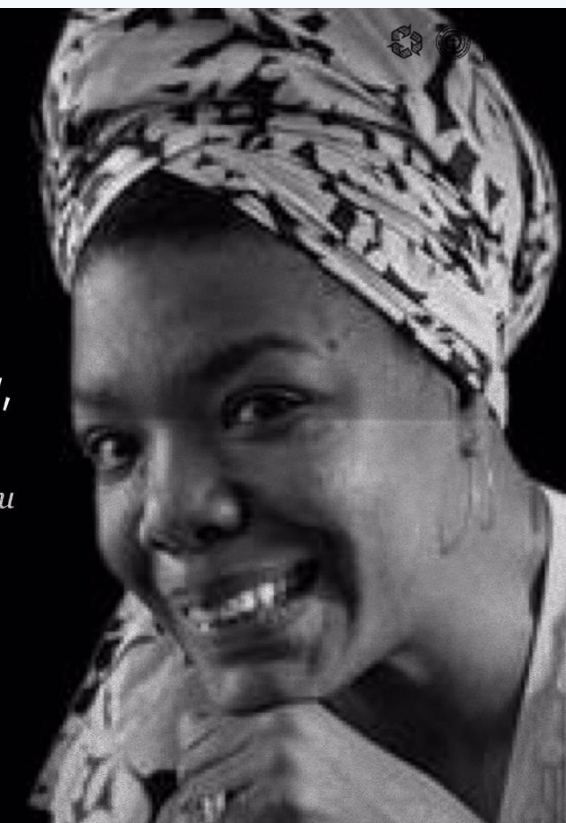

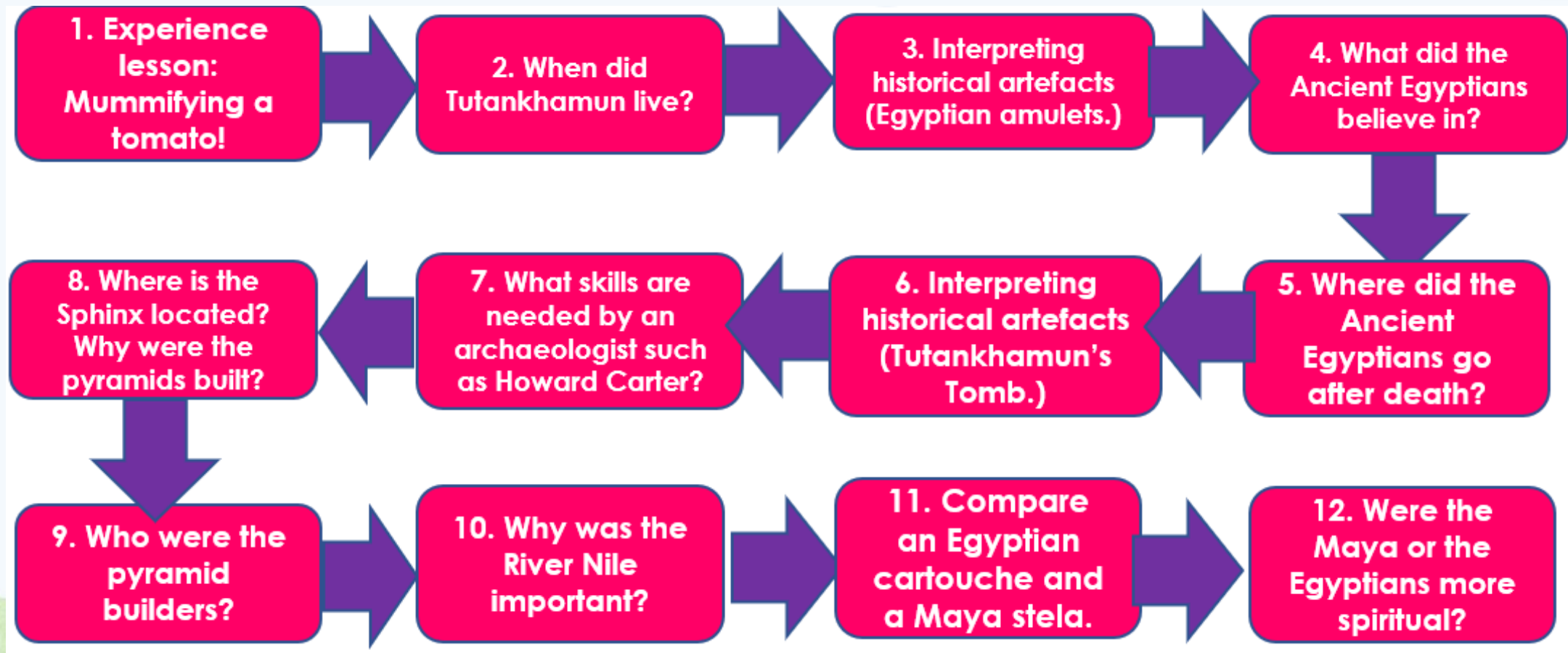

B.C. does stand for "before Christ," but A.D. actually stands for the Latin phrase *anno domini*, which means "in the year of our Lord."

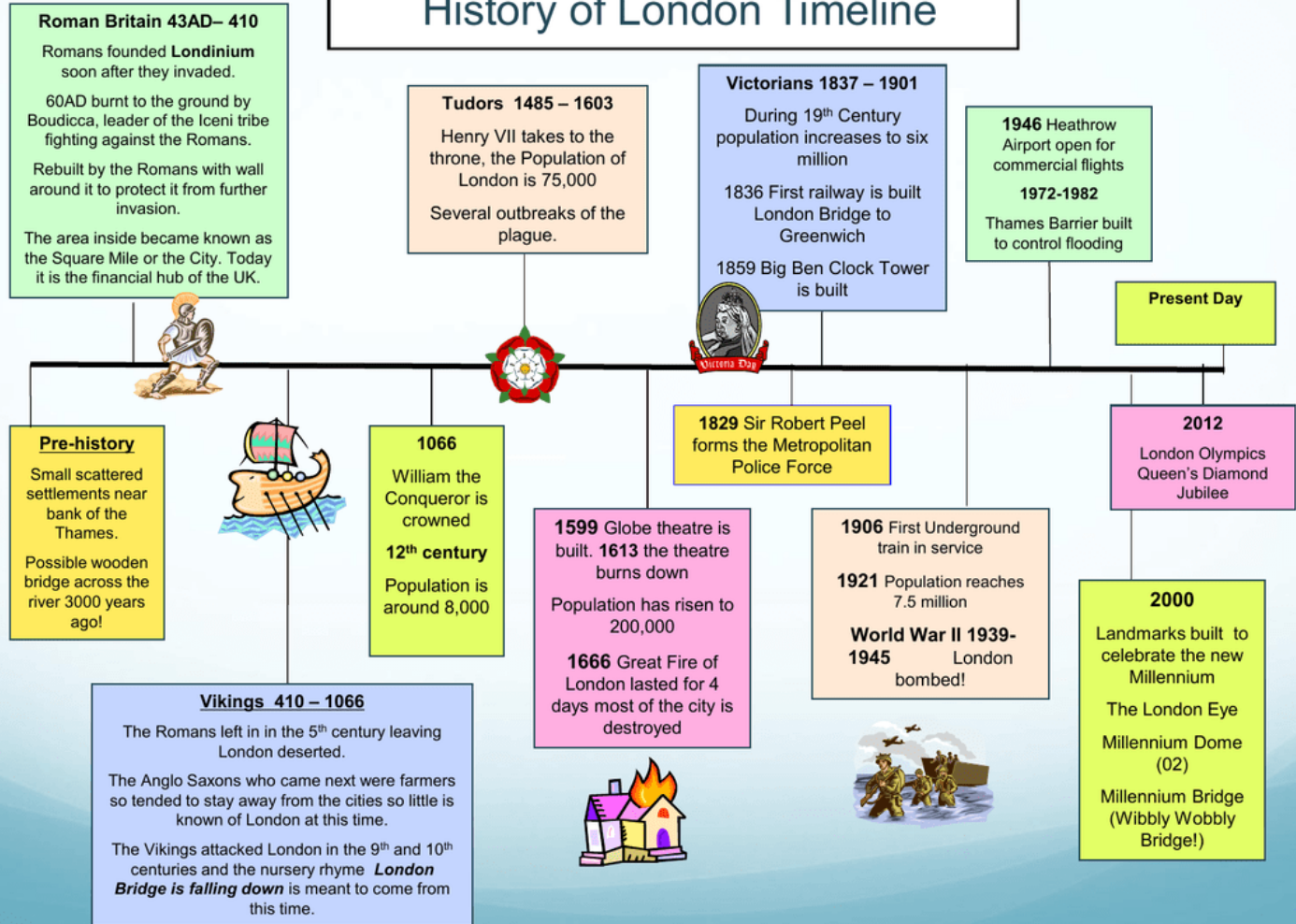

The pharaoh was the ruler in Ancient Egypt

Pharaohs were seen as **gods** on earth.

They were **responsible** for enforcing laws, keeping their citizens safe and making sure that Egypt's land was peaceful and providing crops.

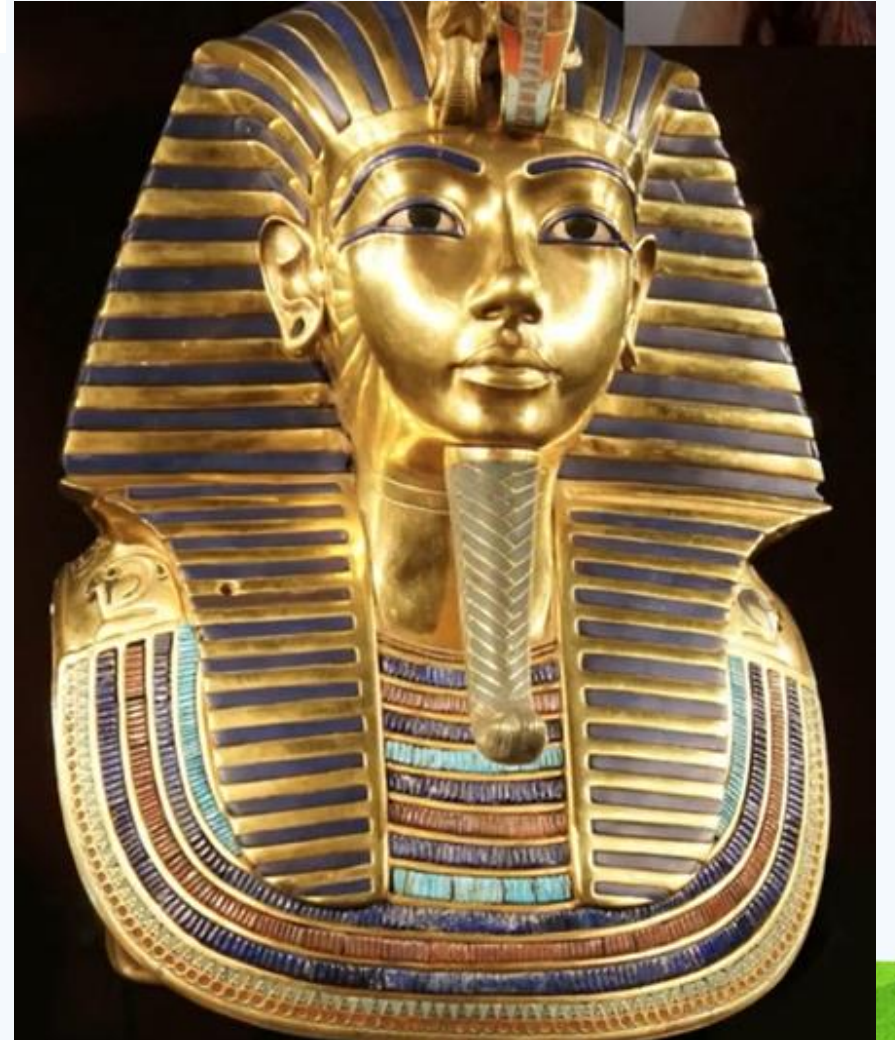
The 'Boy King': Tutankhamun

He became pharaoh in 1333 BC.

Tutankhamun became **pharaoh** at the age of 9.

He died unexpectedly at the age of 19.

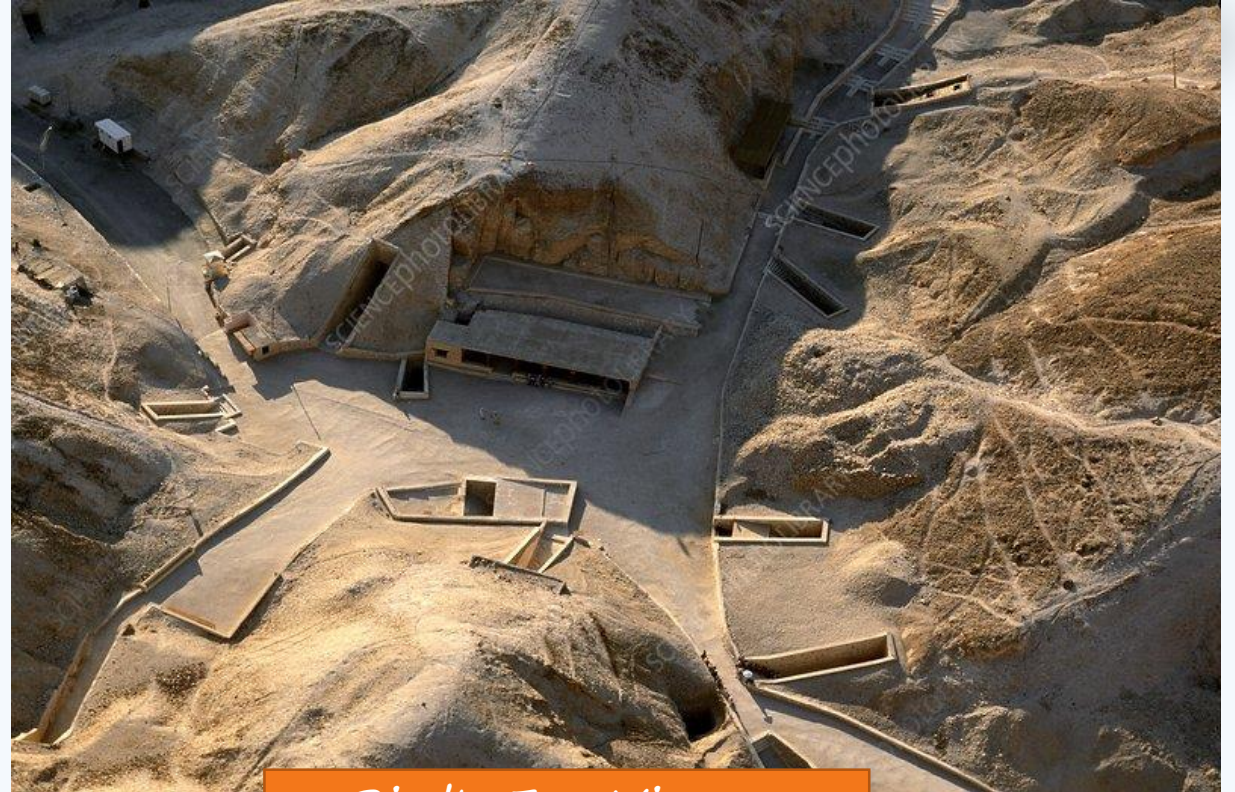
