- ✓ Sticky Knowledge as part of MTPs which children need to understand in order to develop skills in 5 main areas of music.
- ✓ Music Express builds experience and develops understanding of the dimensions of music through progression across units and year groups.
- ✓ Music skills are informally assessed throughout each unit.

- ✓ Working as a team in music groups.

- ✓ Some children are selected to take part in the VAT singing music festival culminating in a collaborative performance with children from across the Trust.
