AREA OF FOCUS	ACTION PLAN
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Continue to up skill staff to give consistent high quality PE provision (£7,800)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All KS1/2 staff have 2 rounds of CPD/ coaching from Head of Primary PE within the VAT (Chris Dowling). Begin with new teachers to Millbrook.</li> <li>Focus coaching on the needs of the teachers. Coaching with CD to follow a specific format – Teachers to be “observed” in week one and three action points are agreed. Throughout the unit, CD to assist teachers in improving upon the agreed action points. Progress made is monitored in final week – CD to observe teacher against their action points.</li> <li>Targeting teachers to send to CPD courses that are appropriate and applicable to their year group’s sporting disciplines.</li> <li>Target teachers for extra coaching where needed – AD to use PE co-ordinate time to work alongside these teachers in planning and/or delivering a PE lesson.</li> <li>Quality of teaching and learning (lesson planning and observation). All teachers to use the Bronze, Silver, Gold concept for their Success Criteria.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Curriculum planning for the future (£0)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Create a curriculum map to ensure good coverage of all sporting disciplines across the year and for each year group.</li> <li>Share the curriculum map with the teachers for them to use when planning each PE unit for each term.</li> <li>Ensure that curriculum map fits well with some of the VAT sporting competitions and activities that are being offered.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Extra-Curricular sporting clubs made available for children of all ages and abilities (some clubs are free if run by members of Millbrook staff, organised clubs run by outside agencies cost – paid by parents of children who attend)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Good range of sporting disciplines offered for the children.</li> <li>Ensuring the enhancement and extension of our curriculum provision – breadth of the sports being offered.</li> <li>Ensure that clubs are inclusive to suit all children of all abilities.</li> <li>Continue to develop links with local clubs in the area.</li> <li>Teachers to promote sports clubs to their PP and SEN children and have a conversation with them about which they have an interest in – can then discuss this with children’s parents.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Continue to participate in a good range of sporting competitions and to be successful in these (£0)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Review our strategy for engaging in competition.</li> <li>Engage more staff, volunteers and parent helpers in attending these sporting events with the children (particularly PP parents).</li> <li>Try to include PP and SEND pupils wherever possible.</li> <li>Release staff to attend events</li> <li>Release staff prior to the event so that the children selected can be trained and coached.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Growth in the range of provisional and alternative sporting activities (included in the £7800)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Investigate alternative possibilities for sports on offer.</li> <li>Use sports leaders to increase range of activities at lunchtimes.</li> <li>Increase variety of sports available in clubs and to the G and T.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Greater awareness amongst pupils about dangers of obesity, smoking and other such activities that undermine pupils health</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Integrate dangers that undermine health into PE lessons.</li> <li>Review content of other subject areas (PSHE) to establish coverage of area.</li> <li>Encourage staff to incorporate these elements into their PE teaching.</li> <li>Focus areas for sessions when weather is bad and no hall is available due to other events.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Continue quality of teaching through constant review of resources and general equipment. (£750)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Review equipment and allocate remaining funding to replacing equipment to be able to teach high quality lessons/ purchasing equipment for new sports. Discuss with all teachers.</li> <li>Purchase equipment also considering what can be purchased with Sainsburys school vouchers at the end of the academic year.</li> </ul>
