**Our Topic**

**Literacy**

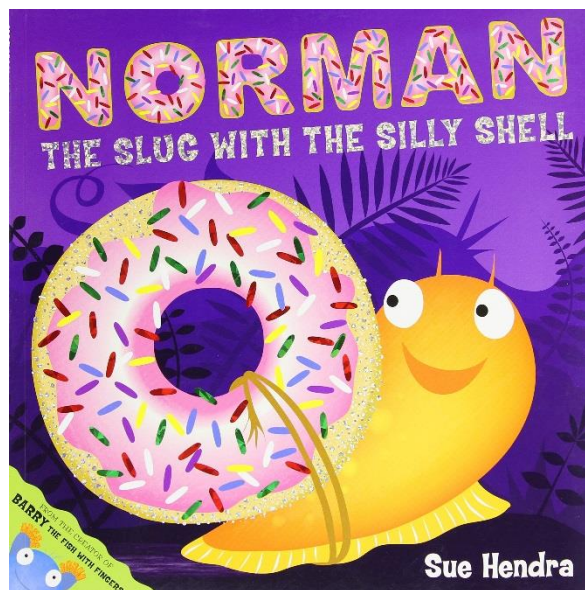
Our storytelling unit this term will be on story writing. The children are going to be making up their own story about an animal.
